What are single courses?

Single courses are subjects from degree programs, available to you even if you're not enrolled as a university student. You take the same classes and complete the same assessment tasks as university students.

What do I need to know?

- Further course information including course descriptions, timetables, credit points and prerequisites are available at www.singlecourses.rmit.edu.au
- Some courses have prerequisites. Please ensure you satisfy these prerequisites prior to applying.
- Some courses will require approval from RMIT University before your application can be finalised. This step in the application process is handled by RMIT Training and is based on information provided at the time of enrolment.
- Applications from current local RMIT students must include written RMIT University approval from your home school.
- RMIT International students are not eligible to enrol in a Single Course offered through RMIT Training Pty Ltd. Please verify your enrolment process with your home school.
- Cancellation requests must be submitted to RMIT Training before the third scheduled class. No refunds will be issued after this date.
- On completion of a Single Course, RMIT Training will issue a result statement confirming your achievement. Your result statement may be used to obtain exemptions, this is not an automatic process and conditions may apply.
